• **INTRODUCTION**

This report covers the state of the district’s membership statistics, achievements and notable events for the period under review.

• **MEMBERSHIP STATISTICS**

The total membership of the District as at the end of 2025 was **7,437**. The detail is as follows: Children under 12 were **2,323**. Children between 12 and 18 years were **1,317**, Youth 18 to under 30 years were by **1,198**. Young Adults 30 to 40 years **948**, with the Adults 40 years and above **1,651**.

• **ACHIEVEMENTS AND EVENTS**

- The District held an Induction Service for the District Minister (**Rev. Daniel Opong-Wereko**) on **25th January, 2026 at the Agape Congregation**. The ceremony was officiated by the Presbytery Chairperson (**Rev. Enock Adjei Pobe**). During the service, members of the newly planted church at **Joma Agbozome on Sunday 14th December, 2026** were introduced to the Presbytery Officers.
- The District was well represented at the one-day **Evangelism and Church Growth Consultation** from **26th February, 2026** at Kaneshie Congregation.
- The district through its ESR Committee on 15th March, 2026, paid a historic visit to the palace of the **Muslim Development Chief of Sempe Traditional Council (Kinkanku Sariki Musah Nsoh)** and his chiefs, to promote interfaith harmony during the Ramadan and the PCG’s Lent season. The delegation was led by the District Minister (**Rev. Daniel Opong-Wereko**), members of the District Standing Committee, Agents and members of the District Singing Band.
- Two members of the District (**Mr. Andrews Adjei and Mrs. Hannah Gyimah**) have completed the Catechists Lay Training Program at Ramseyer Training Centre-Abetifi and will be Consecrated as Catechists on **Friday 27th March, 2026**.
