Introduction

The main preoccupation of this situational report is to highlight the major activities of the Department of Mission and Evangelism from 1st January to 20th March 2026.

Notable Events

1. BIBLE STUDY AND PRAYER GROUP 2025 NATIONAL CONVENTION

Some members of the Ga West Presbytery's BSPG and their Presbytery Coordinator, Rev. Wilson Gyebi Awere participated in the National BSPG convention held from Friday 2nd to Sunday 4th January, 2026 at KNUST Royal Parade Grounds rather than the BSPG Retreat Centre at Tsiapatre, Kumasi in the Asante Presbytery. The convention also marked the climax of the 60th anniversary of the group. The theme for the celebration was Celebrating our Heritage: Building on the Foundation Already Laid – With Perseverance drawn from 1 Corinthians 3:11; James 1:4, and Romans 5:3-5

2. NATIONAL PRAYER MARATHON

The Global Presbyterian Prayer Marathon took place on Sunday 18th January The event organized by the Department of Mission & Evangelism at the National Level was climaxed at the Friedrich Monninger Congregation at Akosombo in the Volta Presbytery. The theme for the Prayers was Celebrating our Heritage: Building on the Foundation Already Laid through Prayer drawn from 1 Corinthians 3:11. The moderator of the General Assembly, Right Rev. Dr. Abraham Nana Opare Kwakye led the prayers at the national level.

The Presbytery was represented by the Nyonmo Dromo congregation at Korobite and was led by the Prayer Centre director, Rev. Nicholas Aryee who prayed from 2:00pm -3:00pm.

The M&E Department at the National level provided prayer topics to guide the prayer sessions

3. EVANGELISM AND CHURCH GROWTH CONSULTATION

The Ga West Presbytery held its first Evangelism and Church Growth Consultation on Friday 26th February, 2026 at the Kaneshie congregation chapel with Rev. Dr. Emmanuel K. Sarbah as the main resource person.

The Consultation focused its attention on discipleship and the theme was “Celebrating our Heritage; Building on the Foundation Already Laid – My Soul My Crown”. Rev. Dr. Sarbah demonstrated how Operation Show Your Convert is undertaken.

4. CHAIRPERSON’S RETREAT WITH DISTRICT MINISTERS AND THEIR SPOUSES

The Chairperson and Clerk of Presbytery hosted District Ministers and their wives to a retreat at the Akuapem Hospitality Centre at Akropong to strategize on how to achieve the presbyteries set goals and targets. The Resource persons for the retreat were Rev. Enoch Pobee, Rev. Abraham Opoku Baffour. The latter gave talks on the ministers’ prayer life. Rev. David Obli, Rev. Kofi Akyeampong and Rev. Michael Oforu-Yeboah led various sections of the retreat in Prayer and sharing of their ministerial journeys. The retreat also afforded Ministers and their spouses to pray on a wide range of issues and also fraternize.

5. MISSION AND EVANGELISM DIRECTORS’ RETREAT

The M&E Director, Rev. Obli participated in the annual retreat held at the Basel Mission Guest House at Adum in the Asante Presbytery from Monday 9th March to Wednesday 11th March, 2026. The retreat concerned itself with prayer in support of the second PCG National Crusade, discipleship and departmental collaboration in evangelism.

6. PCG NATIONAL CRUSADE

The M&E Department at the National level in collaboration with the Asante Presbytery organized the second (2nd) PCG National Crusade at the Kumasi Jubilee Park from Wednesday 11th to Friday 13th March. The Crusade which was beamed live on the various PCG Social Media handles and PCG TV was attended by more than ten thousand people. The principal officers of the church, namely the moderator and Clerk of the General Assembly and several General Assembly Council Members were in attendance. The main speaker of the Crusade was Rev. Eric Okley Botchwey, Madina District Minister. Rev. Obli represented the Ga West Presbytery at the national Crusade. The theme was “Jesus Christ Our Hope and Refuge”. A heavy downpour on the last night interrupted the service for nearly an hour but attendees persisted in prayer and singing until the rains stopped completely and the Crusade resumed and finally ended a few minutes after 10 pm. 7. LAUNCHING OF THE 2025 EVANGELISM WEEK OF THE PCG

The Moderator of the PCG, Right Rev. Dr. Abraham Nana Opore Kwakye assisted by GAC members launched the PCG 2026 Evangelism Week at the Ramseyer Congregation at Sunyani on Sunday 16th March during the fore-noon service. The Asante presbytery donated forty motorbikes whereas the national office presented sixty making a total of one hundred and motorbikes that were distributed among the presbyteries to be given to Agents of the church in less endowed communities. The occasion was witnessed by several chiefs and queen mothers of various communities within the Asanteman.
