SITUATIONAL REPORT FOR 1ST QUARTER (JANUARY TO 19TH MARCH)

Preamble:

Introduction:

This report covers the activities of the district from January to March 19th, 2026 (1st quarter) presented to the Ga West Presbytery Session Council meeting held on Thursday, 26th March, 2026 at Kaneshie.

Update on membership:

The membership of the Manhean district now stands at 3,265 as at the time of writing this report on 19th March, 2026.

Notable events:

1. The Manhean Sub-District had its last Council meeting on the 17th January, 2026 where elections were held for the positions of Lay Rep and Clerk and Mama Doris Boadiwaa was elected as Lay Representative and Mr. David Gorleku was elected as Clerk respectively.
2. Most agents and their spouses took part in the annual health screening organized by the Ga West Presbytery for agents and spouses from 19th to 21st January, 2026 at Kaneshie congregation's Jubilee Hall.
3. The late Rev. Mrs. Comfort Solace Odame was laid to rest on 7th February, 2026 at Graceland Memorial Garden at Blekusu after a burial service was held at in her honour at the Oehler congregation at Manhean. Her final funeral rites were held on the same day at the compound of the Presbyterian Basic School on the same day. Her memorial and Thanksgiving service was however held at the Emmanuel Congregation at Oduman where she was the Minister-In-Charge. The Chairperson of Presbytery, Rev. Enoch Adjei Pobece officiated the burial service and was assisted by Presbytery Council members.
4. The Manhean Sub-District was elevated to a full district status and Rev. David Sowateye Obli was inducted into office as the new district minister on Sunday, 15th February, 2026 by the Chairperson of the Ga West Presbytery supported by the Presbytery Session Council.
5. Cat. Felix Nai Mensah of Christ Family Preaching Point at Oshuiman died at the 37 Military hospital on Thursday, 5th March, 2026.

6. An Introduction service was held for Rev. Kweku Fei Darkwa on Sunday 8th March, 2026 at Trust congregation at Obeyeyie. The Service was officiated by the District Minister, Rev. David S. Obli and was assisted by the District Council members.
