1.0 PREAMBLE

2.0 INTRODUCTION

This report touches on the life of the PCG, Dansoman District and covers all the activities from April to May, 2026.

3.0 KEY RESULTS AREAS

3.1 MISSION & EVANGELISM (M&E)

a) ASHALAJA-POLICE FARMS OUTREACH

Objectives:

To evangelize through an outreach on a weekly basis within the catchment area of Ashalaja-Police Farms.

Activity:

The District continued its evangelism outreach and church service for its members at Ashalaja-Police Farms.

The exercise conducted so far was based on House to House, Street Evangelism & Personal Walk-In.

Results:

Total number of memberships is **95** as at now. **35 Adults** and **60 Children** had fully started a Peaching Point by name PCG Bethel Preaching Point at Ashalaja.

Remarks:

The past weekly outreaches within this year 2026 so far, were successfully organized and carried out with massive involvement from all the representatives from the various congregations within the District.

3.3 CHURCH, LIFE AND NURTURE (CLAN)

EMMAUS DAY-FUN GAMES

Objectives:

- i. To keep both the young and old very fit and to encourage them to socialize more in order to know each other.
- ii. To evangelize through sports.

Activities:

- i. The District organized Inter-Congregational Fun games on Emmaus Day, Monday 6th April, 2025 at Ebenezer Senior High School's premises.
- ii. A House-to-House evangelism was also organized same day prior to the fun games. 25 individuals were reached out to but they are yet to join the Church.
- iii. Various games were incorporated and they include; *Volleyball, Football, Table Tennis, Play Cards, Oware, Ludu, Kids Playstation, & Video Games.*

Remarks:

- i. Participation in various activities was very encouraging. It was also well attended.

3.4 EDUCATION (EDU)

SUBJECT INTERACTION

The District organized subject interaction exercise for its BECE candidates on the Saturday, 18th April, 2026.

Objectives:

To prepare the District JY BECE Candidates towards their final examination.

Activities

The District invited resource persons of the various subjects for the exercise. The resource persons were;

Remarks

Out of the **96 Candidates** expected for the Subject Interaction, only **19 Candidates** showed up to take part of the exercise. Attendance was not encouraging.

UPDATE ON MEMBERSHIP STATISTICS (From April to May, 2026)

The statistics for the District have increased from **8,794** as at the end of December, 2025 to **8,918** as of May 2026 indicating an increase of **124** new members representing **1.4%** as a result of House-to-House/One-on-One Evangelism, Marriages, Personal Walk-in, Naming & Baptismal activities.

NOTABLE EVENTS & ACHIEVEMENTS

- On 5th, 12th & 9th April, 2026, the District continued with the introduction of the newly posted Agents to their Congregations within the District.

PROJECTIONS

- To commence a chaplaincy work at the Dansoman Poly Clinic.
- To have a service with Security Agencies within the District.
- To have a service with Chiefs and their subjects within the District.

MAJOR CHALLENGES

- The District financial standing has not been at its peak due to the immense decrease in service attendance within the various Congregations and Preaching Points.
- The Congregations & Preaching Points within the District appear to experience a general decline in participation in church activities.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The Congregations & Preaching Points within the District are to make their services packages very attractive to encourage members to embrace them with attendance.
- That the Agents in the various stations place emphasis on teachings on Stewardship, Commitment & Christian Maturity which will encourage their members and to deepen the spiritual growth and active participation in church life.
