INTRODUCTION

This report touches on the life of Fise District and covers some key result areas of the Church for the third quarter.

DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

CHURCH LIFE & NURTURE

- The Young People's Guild of the Mt. Sinai Congregation organized a health walk from Ayi Mensah to Kitase Presby. The walk was meant to encourage members to exercise regularly to maintain a healthy lifestyle.

MISSION AND EVANGELISM

- All Congregations organized their Emmaus Day programs successfully. The Fise District Officers went round to witness the various programs. Some of the activities that the various

locals had included; cooking competition, bible quiz, evangelism among others. It was very successful.

- A training on the use of the “So mu bi” and other evangelism materials was organized by the Mount Sinai Congregation for all members on 24th May, 2026. The training was meant to build the capacity of members for evangelism.

DEVELOPMENT AND SOCIAL SERVICES

- On 17th May, 2026, Emmanuel Congregation organized a comprehensive health screening exercise for members. A total of 150 members participated and underwent various medical examinations including; eye tests, liver function test, kidney function test, prostate and breast screening, ear, nose and throat examination, fasting blood sugar test, blood pressure and others. The program enhanced health awareness and encouraged early detection and management of potential health conditions.

ECUMENICAL AND SOCIAL RELATION

- A fire safety awareness program was organized by the Emmanuel Congregation on 24th May, 2026. Retired Fire Service Officer, Mr. Maxwell Afram, facilitated the session and conducted practical demonstrations on fire prevention and emergency response. A total of 248 members attended.
- During the Ramadan period, the Session of Emmanuel Congregation paid a courtesy visit to the Fise Muslim Imam and the Muslim Community and donated twenty (20) packs of bottled water as a gesture of goodwill and support. The engagement fostered cordial relation between the church and the Muslim community and promoted mutual respect among people of different faith.
