2. INTRODUCTION:

- i. Lack of places of worship for newly planted Preaching Points. (Kojo Ashong Preaching Point has been in existence for the past 7 years and they don't have a permanent place of worship. They are currently worshipping on someone's land with a canopy.
 - ii. The Mission Field needs evangelism equipments (Projector, Horns speakers, Microphones, Generator, Projector screen and lighting system) for outreach evangelism.
