INTRODUCTION

This report hints on the life of the Kwashieman District and it covers activities from March to May, 2026.

UPDATE ON MEMBERSHIP STATISTICS

The statistics has increased from six thousand two hundred and sixty-six (6266) at the end of December 2025 to six thousand three hundred and thirty-three (6333). This gives a variance of sixty-seven (67) and a one percentage increment.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The District was able to submit the weekly contributions to the Presbytery. All other statutory payment accrued during the period was also forwarded.

NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENT & EVENTS

- The youth in the district participated in the Ga West Presbytery Youth Games on 7th March, 2026 at Apenkwa. The event was well attended.
- The Hope Congregation, Santa Maria, visited the Santa Maria Mosque on 18th March, 2026 to present food items to the moslem community after their Ramadan.
- The District took its turn with the prayers at Kokrobite on Tuesday 19th March, 2026. Attendance was poorly recorded.
- Forty-four (44) JY members from the district participated in the annual BECE seminar for candidates. The programme took place at Faith Congregation, Capital Hill on 22nd March, 2026. The resource persons were seasoned teachers from the Ga Central Municipal Education Directorate.
- Rev Stephen Nii Armah Ayitey was inducted into office as the Minister in charge of the Peniel Congregation on Sunday, 22nd March, 2026. The programme was officiated by the District Minister with assistance from the District Clerk and Lay Rep.
- The District Choir Union organized a Pre-Easter Concert on Sunday, 29th March, 2026 at Trinity Congregation. Attendance was encouraging as a cross section of District Council members were present.
- The first Council Meeting in the year was held at Trinity Congregation on Sunday, 29th March, 2026. Deliberations were fruitful.

- Members from the various congregations attended the Holy Saturday Prayer Convention organised by the Ga West Presbytery on 4th April, 2026 at Kokrobite. Attendance however was not encouraging enough.
- District YPG had its annual delegates conference at Peniel Congregation from 11th to 12th April, 2026. New executives were elected during conference. The District Minister, District Clerk and DCLAN were in attendance.
- Cat. Magnus Acolor was inducted as catechist in charge of the Faith Congregation on 19th April, 2026. The District Minister officiated and he was assisted by the District Clerk and Lay Rep to Presbytery.
- Due to popular request, the district organised another seminar for the BECE candidates in the district from 19th April, 2026 at the Trinity Congregation. The candidates were taken through the 4 core subjects after which they were refreshed.
- The Kwashieman District hosted the 10th Presbytery Session of the Ga West Presbytery from 23rd to 26th April, 2026. The highlight of the session was the election of a new Chairperson for the Presbytery. The four-day event went well with massive attendance of both delegates and members in attendance.
- The Annual District Prayer Convention took place at the Trinity Congregation, Kwashieman on 1st May, 2026. All agents in the district participated and the sermon was given by the District Minister; Rev. Kofi Manukure Akyeampong.
- District YAF had its annual delegates conference on 17th May, 2026 at the Prince of Peace Congregation. The Associate Minister of Trinity Congregation; Rev Nicholas Martey represented the district minister and administered communion to participants. Election of new executives was conducted under the supervision of the district clerk and DCLAN.
- An Introductory service in honour of Cat Robert Afenyin Dompheh was held at Trinity Congregation on 17th May, 2026. The service was officiated by the District Minister with assistance from the District Clerk and the Lay Rep.
- All congregations in the district participated fully in the Kutunse Fundraising declared for all congregations in the Presbyterian Church of Ghana. This was held on 31st May, 2026 with active involvement of members.

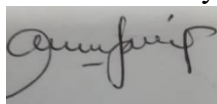
