Introduction:

This report covers the activities of the district in April and May presented to the Ga West Presbytery Session Council meeting held on Thursday, 11th June, 2026 at Kaneshie.

Update on membership:

The membership of the Manhean district now stands at 3,265 as at the end of the first quarter. Waiting to update at the end of June (Second quarter).

Notable events:

1. Emmaus Day celebration – All locals organized good Friday service, Saturday prayer session, Palm Sunday procession. The Emmaus day games was localized this year to ensure that, most of the locals take part.
2. Y.A.F Sunday was held on 19th April, 2026 in all the locals in the district.
3. Men's Fellowship of Peace congregation was inaugurated by the District Minister on 19th April, 2026.
