a). Prayer Convention: Approximately three thousand (3000) members of the Presbytery converged at the Ga West Presbytery Prayer Centre on Holy Saturday, 4th April to seek the face of God via pray to end the Lenten period, while the congregations in the Mission Field on the other hand held hers in the Mission field.
