SITUATIONAL REPORT PRESENTED TO THE 2026 PRESBYTERY SESSION
COUNCIL COVERING THE PERIOD JULY TO SEPTEMBER, 2026.

➤ **PREAMBLE**

➤ **INTRODUCTION**

This report covers the state of the district’s membership statistics, achievements and notable events for the period under review.

➤ **MEMBERSHIP STATISTICS**

The total membership of the District as at September 2026 is **7,684**. The detail is as follows: Children under 12 were **2,368**. Children between 12 and 18 years were **1,382**, Youth 18 to under 30 years were by **1,251**. Young Adults 30 to 40 years **991**, with the Adults 40 years and above **1,692**.

➤ **ACHIEVEMENTS AND EVENTS**

• **ADMINISTRATION AND HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT**

- a. In the period under review, there was a general transfer of Catechists and Caretakers in the District.
- b. We had Valedictory services for two Catechists (**Cat. Elijah Adom Mpere and Cat. Samuel Agyekum Mensah**) and a minister (**Rev. Ebenezer Kwafo Ansah**).
- c. A Music Festival was organized on **26th July, 2026** at Resurrection Congregation to honour and celebrate four Agents who were going on retirement this year.
- d. In the period under review, a new minister was transferred to the District as Minister in Charge of Ascension Congregation in the person of **Rev. Rosemond Maku Gardner-Korli**.
- e. The District has recruited three persons as Caretakers who will be undergoing training to become Catechists in the ensuing year. They are: **Mr. Christian Humble, Mr. Paul Akowuah, and Mrs. Janet Twento**.
- f. All Committees in the District have been revised and reconstituted with new members to ensure effectiveness and efficiency.

• **ECUMENICAL AND SOCIAL RETAIONS**

The District visited the palace of Olebu Mantse and his chiefs on **29th August, 2026**, to promote interfaith harmony. The delegation was led by the District Minister (**Rev. Daniel Opong-**

Wereko), members of the District Standing Committee, Agents and members of the District Singing Band.

- **EDUCATION**

The District Education Committee organized **PENS DOWN PRAISE** at Christ the King Congregation on **22nd August, 2026**. This is an annual program for BECE and WASSCE candidates to thank God for a successful completion of their studies. The program was well attended and very successful.

- **CLAN**

- a. The District JY organized a Camp Meeting for members of the Junior Youth on **27th to 30th August, 2026** at Afienya Technical Institute. The Camp meeting was well attended and very successful.
- b. There has be retreats, training workshops and commissioning for newly elected Presbyters in various Congregations in the District. This is to equip them and enhance the effectiveness of their service in the church.

- **MISSION AND EVANGELISM**

- a. The District organized an Evangelism Consultation on **3rd July, 2026** at Resurrection Congregation. All locals reported on their evangelistic activities and projections for the year.
- b. The District YPG will be embarking on their annual Presbyterian Youth in Church Evangelism (P-YICE) at Bethel Congregation on **17th to 20th September, 2026**.
- c. The District has also made available evangelism tracts and materials to all Congregations to help enhance the *“Operation Show Your Convert” and Agenda 2 million souls*.
- d. Six Motorbikes were dedicated by the Presbytery Chairperson on **25th August, 2026** at Agape Congregation. One motorbike was given to the Agbozome Preaching Point in Ablekuma District, one to the Ga West Presbytery Prayer Centre, one to Agyen Kotoku Congregation and another one was given to the Purpose Driven Ministries to aid evangelism activities. The Bikes were donated by the District Minister, Rev. Daniel Opong-Wereko and his Team of Donors.
