2.0 INTRODUCTION

I present to you, a situational report on the activities of PCG, Amasaman District for the period, from July to September 2026.

3.0 NOTABLE EVENTS

A. EVANGELISM (PYICE)

The District organized, PYICE from 2th to 27th June, 202 at Akramaman area. The attendance were 30 youths. Seven souls were won, five (5) females and two (2) men.

B. PRESBYTERY YPG ZONAL QUIZ

The District YPG participated in the Presbytery Zonal Quiz and Amasaman District came 3rd out of the 10 istricts on the 14th June, 2026 hosted at Larterbiokorshie District
