2.0 INTRODUCTION

This situational report covers the activities of the Lartebiokorshie District from June 2026 to mid-September 2026.

3.0 ACTIVITIES

3.1 ADMINISTRATION AND HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

- i. Following the transfer of ministers, the Macedonia Congregation, Mataheko, saw Rev. Mrs. Vera Djan Amponsah off on Sunday, 6th September 2026. The Congregation is yet to receive the minister who will replace her. Similarly, Rev. Samuel Adom Adjah was sent off on Sunday, 13th September 2026. 3.2 FINANCE

The weekly contribution of the 52/48 arrangement, as well as funds from all statutory celebrations held within the period under review, have been duly remitted to the Presbytery.

3.3 MISSION AND EVANGELISM
