3RD SITUATIONAL REPORT FOR 2026 SUBMITTED TO THE GA WEST PRESBYTERY COUNCIL MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 2026

PREAMBLE:

'Sing ye saints, sing to the Saviour, Jehovah is He. Give Him thanks, and praise Him always, Praise Him everywhere. Christians come, your Lord extol, Magnify His Blessed Name. Give Him thanks and praise your Saviour, Glorify His Name.' (PH 3 Stanza1).

1. INTRODUCTION:

This Situational report covers the activities of the New Achimota District for the period 10th June to 23rd September, 2026. The report focuses on some notable events and issues for consideration by the Council.

2. NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS AND EVENTS

a) District Church Planting and Salvation YPG Evangelism at Ahiabu

The District, as part of the fulfillment of the Bicentennial Church Planting requirement of the Church, has already started a Church at Ahiabu in the Adjen-Kotoku District and has been in constant worship on Sundays there with a committed and dedicated team led by the Chairperson of the District's Mission and Evangelism Committee, Mr. Emmanuel Andzie-Quainoo (initially the Caretaker for Grace Preaching Point in our District, now the Caretaker for Ahiabu).

The Salvation YPG undertook a 2-day non-residential evangelism outreach at Ahiabu as part of contributing towards the growth of the newly-planted Church. The exercise took place on Sat. 27th and Sun. 28th June, 2026 and included house-to-house evangelism and film show on the Saturday. The Team fellowshiped with the Preaching Point on the Sunday.

b) Commissioning Services

Brothers, now Reverends Bismark Osaе and Nathaniel Tetteh Kudjoe Larkpleku (both members of the Salvation Congregation) were on 7th June, 2026 and 18th July, 2026 commissioned into the Ordained Ministry at the Peniel Congregation -Teshie and the Ramseyer Congregation-Abetifi respectively.

The Post-Commissioning Thanksgiving and Send Off Service for the former was held on 7th August, 2026 at the Salvation Congregation. That for the latter is scheduled for 18th October, 2026 at same venue. They were seen off to their new Stations ie. Adidwan in the Sekyere Presbytery and Amasaman District by the Salvation Congregation on Tuesday 15th September and Sunday 13th September, 2026 respectively.

c) **Valedictory, Thanksgiving, Commissioning, Consecration and Send Off Services**

NB: In view of the transfer of some Ministers out of the District and the retirement of one of them, the following Ministers were transferred into the District within the period:

- Rev. Rosemond Maku Gardiner-Korli has been replaced by Rev. Willian Gyan Yirenkyi;
- Rev. Godfred Sakyiama Amoako, replaced by Rev. Rebecca Fredricka Akweley Abladey and;
- Rev. Kwasi Kyei-Baffour is retiring, replaced by Rev. Walter Kpentey.

d) **Hosting of Ordination of Ministerial Probationers**

The District hosted the Ordination of twenty six (26) Ministerial Probationers held at the Salvation Congregation on 12th July, 2026. The event was successful to the glory of God.

e) **Prayer Convention**

The District held her 5th edition of the annual Prayer Convention from 20th to 24th July, 2026 under the theme 'God is able' (Luke 1:37, Jer.32:17). The program was led by Evangelist Isaac Akwasi Acheampong, a Presbyterian Evangelist at Akim Oda. The 5-day event was packed with powerful ministration of the word of God and deliverance of His people.

f) **Maiden Youth Convocation**

Four hundred and twenty (420) young people in JY and YPG from the various Congregations and Preaching Points in the District were brought together for the maiden Youth Convocation of the District. In fulfillment of Decision 7 of the 18th District Session Decisions that required '*That an Annual Youth Convocation be held to engage the youth on issues that relate to them (CLAN to take charge).*'

Addressing the gathering, the 1st Speaker, Mrs. SallyAnn Ampomah, a Seasoned Counselor, Lecturer (at Knutsford University) and member of the Christ The King Congregation in the District challenged the youth on the topic: 'Faith, Work and the Future; Building a Career with God at the Center.' (Prov. 3:56, Matt. 6:33, Jer. 29:11).

Rev. Dr. Kofi Aidoo, a Psychiatrist and Minister in the Adenta District was the 2nd Speaker. He spoke on the theme: 'Changing the world by the Word.' He emphasized the need to study the word of God in order to positively impact this dynamic world and remain relevant to one's calling.

The Program was spearheaded by the Committee on Church Life And Nurture of the District. Participation was massive and engaging. There were Choreography, Spoken Word and Song Ministrations by participants to spice up the day.

There was a Panel discussion to also address some concerns of the participants.

In all, the program was very successful. It is our prayer that the lessons shared will make positive impacts in the lives of our youth.

g) **Funeral of the late Cat. Ebenezer Asare Pabi**

The one week observance of the late Cat. Ebenezer Asare Pabi, who until his demise on 12th July, 2026, was in charge of the Gethsemane Congregation in the District was held

on 25th July, 2026. The burial service and final funeral rites took place on 5th September, 2026 at the Salvation Congregation. We acknowledge the presence of the Chairperson of Presbytery, Rev. David Sowateye Obli.

The service was also loaded with the presence of the Presbytery and District Catechists Conferences among other persons. The burial took place at Pabi, his hometown. The Thanksgiving Service was held on 6th July, 2026 at the same Congregation.

Meanwhile, Mad. Reater Nii Koi has been posted to the District as a Caretaker for the Congregation. Prior to this, Rev. Bismark Osaе (newly commissioned member) and Catechist Michael Asare Ansah (Catechist-with-Charge of the Calvary Congregation) held oversight responsibilities at the Congregation in the absence of Cat. Pabi. The District is grateful to them.

h) Climax of 50th Anniversary Celebrations

The Salvation Congregation was the place to be on 23rd August, 2026. The Congregation's 50th Anniversary Celebration was Climax in a grand style. The Moderator of the General Assembly of the Church, Rt. Rv. Dr. Abraham Nana Opare Kwakye preached the Sermon for the day. The Clerk of General Assembly, Rev. David Aboagye Danquah, the former Chief of Staff, Hon. Akosua Frema Opare and other dignitaries were present to grace the occasion. Activities for the day included the recognition of founding members (both dead and alive), the singing of the composed Anniversary song, cutting of the Anniversary Cake etc. To God be the glory.

i) Musical Program Towards District Minister's Send Off

Prior to his send off, the District organized a Musical Program in appreciation to God for the life and Ministry of the then outgoing District Minister, Rev. Michael Addoquaye Addo. In the cool evening of 30th August, 2026, members, dressed in all-white converged at the Salvation Congregation and offered melodious songs to God through the District Church Choirs' Union and Singing Band. Members shared testimonies of God's goodness during the period of Rev. Addo's service in the District. In his address to the gathering, Rev. Addo expressed his appreciation to God Almighty for how far He has brought him. He also thanked all and sundry for the support offered him so far and pledged his continual support where need be.

j) District YAF Donation towards Evangelism

Within the period under review also, the Young Adults' Fellowship (YAF) in the District donated Ten Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc10,000.00) in support of Evangelism activities in the District. The amount was used to acquire a Mini Mixer, two (2) Speakers, Microphones and Cable. We are grateful to them.

Furthermore, the District intends to make more evangelism equipment available. These aside being used by the mother District, will be available for use by the Congregations and Preaching Points within the District for evangelism purposes.

k) **District YAF Outreach at Ahiabu**

The District YAF successfully organized a 2-day Evangelism Mission at Ahiabu. The mission forms part of the group's commitment to supporting church growth and strengthening our Preaching Points.

The team was led by the District YAF President, Bro. George Ayeh Bekoe, and accompanied by the District Mission & Evangelism Committee Chairperson, Mr. Emmanuel Andzie Quainoo. In all, eight (8) persons took part in the outreach.

Activities undertaken include House-to-House Evangelism. A total of 25 people were reached out to and expressed willingness to fellowship with the Ahiabu Preaching Point. Follow ups will be done for effective integration into the Church.

As a direct result of the outreach, three (3) of the newly-won souls attended church service on the following Sunday and have expressed their desire to become part of the Church.

In support of the growth and effective worship of the Preaching Point, the District YAF donated the following items to the Preaching Point:

1. Fifteen (15) plastic chairs;
2. One (1) 4ft by 4ft Signage/ Signboard;
3. Ten (10) copies of Twi Hymn Books and;
4. Assorted Stationery - Exercise books, Pencils and Pens.

The District is grateful to the team for the great work done and pray that these souls won will remain with Christ.

l) **Commencement of a New Chapel for Faith Preaching Point (PP)/ Prayer Center Proposal**

To the glory of God, the Faith Preaching Point in the District will soon have a better place of worship. Works have begun on the new land that was acquired through the loan facility obtained from the Salvation Credit Union. The District received an amount of One Hundred and Twenty Thousand Ghana Cedis (GHc120,000.00) from a benevolent couple through Cat. George Asiedu, Catechist-with-Charge of the Salvation Congregation. Gracefully, works are currently on-going on the land.

The District has proposed to use the current place of worship of the Preaching Point as a Prayer Center in the interim whiles we identify a suitable buyer for the place.

m) **District YPG Evangelism**

On 19th September, 2026, twenty (20) souls were won by the District YPG in an evangelism activity held in the Spot 'M' enclave ie. the Gethsemane Congregation. One (1) of the souls fellowshipped with the Congregation the following day. Follow ups will be done to bring the others on board.

n) **Hosting of Moderator's Visit**

The District, together with four others in zone one namely: Abeka, Apenkwa, Kaneshie and North Kaneshie on Wed. 24th June, 2026, hosted the Moderator of the General Assembly to a lunch as part of his pastoral visit to the Ga West Presbytery at the Salvation Congregation. The special visit was marked with a warm welcome ceremony led by some Pupils of the New Achimota Presby Basic School, the Women's

Fellowship, Singing Band and other members of the Church. Each District did a 5-minutes Presentation on their date of establishment, statistics, Agents, their significant attributes and contributions towards the Bicentennial Celebration and to the Kutunse Project.

The Moderator, in his address to the gathering, admonished all to deeply partake in the Bicentennial celebrations as well as the patronization of the Bicentennial items such Bibles, Cloth and other. He further warned against illegal mining and clearly portrayed the Church's stance against it. He urged members to be responsible towards the cleanliness of their environments. He further explained the P.C.G. Logo and its significance and urged members to stay united as a Church.

o) **Participation in the 70th National Singing Band Conference**

The District Singing Band participated in the National Conference of the Band held at the Accra Academy Senior High School from 3rd to 6th September, 2026. It was all joy as the various Band sang and danced in appreciation to God for His faithfulness throughout the year.

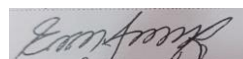
