SITUATIONAL REPORT (JULY - SEPTEMBER 2026) SUBMITTED TO THE
GA WEST PRESBYTERY COUNCIL MEETING

1.0 Preamble / Introduction

2.0 Notable Achievement and Events

2.1 All Congregations and Preaching Points observed the statutory events on the Almanac for the period under review and proceeds remitted to the higher Courts.

2.2 The district attended all conferences slated for the second half of the year and made donations towards their conferences.

2.3 The district visited the Gbawe and Weija palaces on 6th and 7th August respectively to make donations for the celebration of Homowo. This time Unity and Riis congregations participated and also made donations.

2.4 The district all-night prayer session dubbed Alokoto All-night came off at Riis Congregation on 28th August. About 50 people attended. The guest speaker was Evangelist Kwadwo Darko.

2.5 The district held a valedictory service for Cat. Stephen Onomah Asante at Ebenezer Congregation on 30th August 2026. A committee was formed by the district to liaise with the local organising committee to plan and executed the farewell service. Congregations were tasked to bring specific contributions towards the programme.

2.6 Mission activities to Jei Krodua has continued every Sunday since the preaching point was re-birthed on 28th December 2025. On 9th August 2026, 15 children and 1 adult were baptised to the glory of God.

2.7 To uphold the Catechist Institution, the district has added 2 catechists by training one and receiving another on transfer. On 1st September 2026 posted them to the designated congregations as follows:

- a. Catechist Rita Ampofo was posted to Ga West Model Church, Tetegu.
- b. Catechist Emma Ohenewaa Buahing was posted to Ebenezer Congregation, Mendskrom.

2.8 Inauguration service was conducted for the District Junior Youth Fellowship on 6th September 2026.

2.9 To the glory of God the district roofed the Oblogo chapel in August 2026 and handed it over on 20th September 2026 for the preaching point to continue at a short ceremony at the premises.

2.10 The District participated in the presbytery CLAN meeting.

2.14 The District attended the send-off service for the outgoing presbytery chairperson.
